Letter dated 8 February 2010 from the Secretary-General addressed to the President of the Security Council

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1903 (2009) concerning Liberia, adopted on 17 December 2009, whereby the Council decided to extend the mandate of the Panel of Experts appointed pursuant to paragraph 4 of resolution 1854 (2008) until 20 December 2010 so that it can undertake the tasks set forth in paragraph 9 of resolution 1903 (2009). By the same resolution, the Council requested me to reappoint the members of the Panel of Experts and to make the necessary financial and security arrangements to support the work of the Panel.

Accordingly, I wish to inform you that I have appointed the following experts:

Mr. Rowan Bosworth-Davies (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, finance expert)
Mr. Hervé Gonsolin (France, arms expert)
Ms. Wynet V. Smith (Canada, expert on natural resources)

I have also designated Ms. Smith as Coordinator of the Panel of Experts.

I should be grateful if you would bring this information to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
