Ministerial decision No. 6 of 2008

Title: Decision to extend fast-tracking for Darfur

1. The Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs, seeking to enhance humanitarian conditions in Darfur, and on the basis of the joint communiqué between the Government of the Sudan and the United Nations regarding the facilitation of the flow of humanitarian aid to Darfur and the provision of facilities to humanitarian aid partners, including United Nations organizations and agencies and donors;
2. Therefore decides:
 - (a) To extend fast-track measures for Darfur until 31 January 2010;
 - (b) The agencies concerned shall work under this decision and shall implement the fast-track measures in accordance with the general procedure guide.
3. This decision shall enter into force from the date on which it was signed.
